Lateness

Unfortunately we still have a number of pupils arriving in the morning after the gate is closed and being collected late at the end of the day. Whilst we appreciate on some occasions or circumstances lateness cannot be avoided, please ensure that you are allowing enough time for your journey. Arriving at school late means starting the day unsettled and, most likely, missing the beginning of the first lesson. This makes it hard for children to understand what is being taught. We do not have the staff to sit with your child/ren if you are late which means staff are being taken away from their other duties.

After School Clubs

Clubs finish at 4pm prompt, with the exception of Curious Maths, which finishes at 4.30pm. Please make sure your child is collected on time as if you collect your child late, they may lose their place in the club. We do not have staff to look after your child once they have finished the club. Good behaviour is also expected at clubs just as much as in school. If your child's behaviour at clubs becomes a concern they may also lose their place.
