Secondary School Application Deadline - 31 October 2022

Applications for secondary school must be made online at **www.eadmissions.org.uk on midnight on Monday 31 October 2022.** You will require an email address.

Please <u>click here</u> to start your application. Selecting the right secondary school for your child is important and you should nominate up to **six schools** in order of preference. Applying for only one school will not improve your chances of getting a place at that school.

This week there was a whole school assembly about harvest and sharing. We talked about the role of the foodbank in our local community. If you are able to donate,

please can your child bring their donations into their class in a carrier bag where the donations will be displayed in the hall. Your child can bring in their donations until next Tuesday 11 October. Many thanks to those families who have already contributed.

What can my child have in their packed lunch and what are they not allowed? Hope this makes things clearer for you. We are really trying to encourage healthy eating at Carterhatch Juniors. A packed lunch can be left over food from the night before in a flask so it is kept warm, especially now the weather is colder!

A sandwich with ham/chicken/salad/cheese is filling and quick to make. A packet of crisp, yoghurts, cucumber/ carrot sticks, grapes, strawberries, apples, oranges are a few examples of what you can include in a packed lunch. You should not pack anything in your child lunch box that contains NUTS. We have children that have nut allergies so nuts are not allowed in school in any snacks.


