**Breakfast club will re-open on Monday 14 September**, once we have a clear picture of numbers of pupils and which year groups they are in. Forms to register (if you haven't in the past) can be downloaded from our school website.

Pupils should wear full uniform. Face masks are not necessary in school. Pupils should not bring any rucksacks or bags into school, just a labelled water bottle, a packed lunch (if they don't have school dinners) and PE kit on the day they have PE. If you would like your child's exercise books from this year, on the first day back, please send a plastic bag with your child to take them home. After that, they will be disposed of.

As explained in my earlier letter, every year group will be completing Art work about themselves and on the theme of 'Identity and Heritage'. For home learning over the summer holidays we are asking pupils to think about themselves, their interests and their families and to bring into school photos, books they like, quotations about themselves and objects in a named box or bag in the first week back.

There are a number of documents you may want to read - our risk assessments, the new home-school agreement, parent guidance and Behaviour Addendum. These will be on our website by 4 September. In line with Government guidance, "systems of control" will be in place. These are:

- Washing hands throughout the day
- Promoting "catch it, bin it, kill it"
- Cleaning of the school throughout the day
- Minimising contact with individuals showing symptoms of coronavirus
- Following public health procedures and NHS Test and Trace processes if there is a suspected or confirmed case of coronavirus

I would like to wish you a happy and healthy summer break. We are all looking forward to welcoming all our pupils back in September. It will be fantastic to see everyone again.
